

Who Qualifies?

Asthma Start is a **NO COST** program for the parents/guardians of children diagnosed with asthma, providing in-home case management services which addresses the medical, environmental, and psychosocial needs of families.



Who Qualifies?

A person is eligible to participate in the Asthma Start Program if <u>ALL</u> of the following requirements are met:

- Lives in Alameda County
- Is 0-18 years of age
- · Has been diagnosed with asthma

What Services Are Offered?

- Asthma education to families (i.e. symptoms, triggers, prevention, medication, etc.).
- In-home inspections for asthma triggers (i.e. mold, pests, dust, etc.).
- Referrals for housing, employment, and health insurance.
